HOA notes:

When renting the clubhouse, the pool is not included with the rental to avoid overcrowding at the pool.

Fences and repairs:

4ft wood fences are the only allowed installations unless property backs up to a collector street. Please get approval from the architectural committee when modifying decks, fencing, house paint colors, home additions, etc.

Trailers, boats and ladders must be garaged.

Pets:

Must be leashed. Noisy dogs generate complaints. Keep them under control.

Lawn care:

Lawn clippings need to be removed from streets after mowing to keep Cheddington looking nice. Lawn clippings belong in the yard or out for compost pickup. Those with sprinklers: save money by ensuring your heads are adjusted to not water the pavement.
